

## Placing your trash for curbside pickup

Correct placement of your container for curbside trash, recycling and organic waste collection is easy, but it's also important to ensure your services are handled properly and safely. We don't want to miss your collection, but we can't pick up your trash if it isn't by the curb when our truck gets there on your service day. This guide on container placement will ensure you're prepared:

- Place your trash can and recycling bin at the curb with the wheels facing your house and the lid opening into the street.
- Keep your garbage cans four feet apart and at least four feet or more from any obstacles such as mailboxes, cars, lamp posts, or power lines.
- Keep your container at the curb until the end of the day if it hasn't been collected. Sometimes the timing of our arrival changes, and we don't want to miss you if we come later than expected.
- It's generally best to put your container out **the night before your collection day**. That way even if we're early, you won't miss your pick-up.







Dear Citizens,

Attached you will find information from GFL on their garbage pick-up services. We are trying to be sure everyone gets their garbage picked up on schedule.

Also, you may not be aware of a special service provided to senior citizens with disabilities. If you are unable to push your garbage cart to the road, please call the Town Hall and request this service. If approved, you may leave the garbage cart at the front of the house and they will come get it, dump it, and bring it back.

If your cart does not get emptied, or is damaged in the pick-up process, you may call GFL directly to request that they return to pick up your garbage. The number to call is 252-291-6635 option #3.

Please also keep in mind that GFL does not pick up yard waste. The Town will pick up yard waste on Fridays. Please do not put any yard waste in your GFL cart.
